What is an EOB?

An EOB is a statement that shows the healthcare services you received. It also shows what your health plan paid and the amount you owe.

An EOB is not a bill, but it helps you keep track of some important information:

- How much your provider charged for services
- How much of those charges your health plan covers
- The amount your health plan paid
- The amount you owe, including deductibles, copays or coinsurance

How to Locate Explanations of Benefits (EOBs)

- Navigate to https://app.bluecareadvisormn.com/ and enter your login credentials.
- On the Home page, click on Recent Claims.



• Explanations of Benefits are individually tied to their respective claim – to view specific EOBs, click on the visit for which you'd like to view an EOB.
